A PreK Program That Stands Apart

- **Progressive, Quaker education** that nurtures kindness, reflection, and community, guiding children and faculty to practice peace, integrity, and respect in their daily interactions.
- **Play-based learning** with hands-on exploration, inquiry, and creative problem-solving.
- **Kindergarten readiness,** balancing social-emotional development, early literacy, and math skills to ensure children are prepared for their next steps.
- **Outdoor education**, including daily outdoor play and nature-based learning on our beautiful campus to foster wonder, curiosity, and a deep connection to the environment.
- **Small class size,** ensuring each child receives individualized attention and care.
- **Specials classes** such as art, World Languages, and movement, driven by student interest, and supporting a well-rounded early learning experience.
- Meeting Partners, where each lower school student is paired with a middle school peer, fostering mentorship, confidence, and a strong sense of community and belonging.

Academic Development in Our Youngest Learners

We intentionally weave our Central Study theme and students' natural interests and curiosities into our yearly curricular scope and sequence, focusing on building the following skills and competencies:

- **Effective Communication** Children learn to express themselves clearly and understand others, building confidence in their ideas and strengthening relationships with peers and teachers.
- **Problem-Solving** Whether in math, science, play, or everyday challenges, students develop the ability to explore solutions with curiosity and resilience.
- **Social-Emotional Growth** By recognizing emotions, practicing selfregulation, and navigating social interactions, children build empathy, independence, and the skills needed to thrive in a community.
- Active Listening More than just hearing and our students practice active listening to engage deeply with learning and build meaningful connections.
- **Early Literacy Skills** Through phonological awareness, letter-sound connections, and fluency checks, we lay the foundation for future reading success.
- **Early Math Foundations** Through play and exploration, children develop number recognition and number sense, fostering confidence in mathematical thinking.

The Rhythm of Our PreK Experience

Our weekly schedule is tailored each year to best suit the needs of our community, but the daily flow remains largely the same. *What I Need* (WIN) time is proactively scheduled throughout each day to ensure a flexibility that supports individualized instruction and student need.
